Clinical Audit – Cervical Screening Test | 2017–2019

Gain statistical insights into the new cervical screening program

The National Cervical Screening Program has introduced significant changes to the way cervical screening tests (CST) are performed in Australia. Sonic Healthcare has created a CST audit to provide participating practitioners with comparative statistical data to better understand the clinical implications of the new reporting systems, and to reflect upon possible practice improvements and learning opportunities.

How it works

1 Register

Register online at register.apps.sonichealthcare.com/audits, or complete the attached registration form and fax to (02) 4224 7461.

Once you have registered, you will receive a confirmation email, and data collection will commence.

2 Receive your reports

The audit is conducted over a 12-month period, and participants receive personalised interval reports 6 and 12 months after registration. The multi-page report contains tables outlining a summary of your patients' CST results divided into age categories, as well as charts comparing your personal outcomes to those of your general practitioner peer group and a national GP cohort.

3 Submit your personal evaluation questionnaire at the end of each reporting period

After reviewing your reports, personal evaluation questionnaires must be submitted for each of the two consecutive 6-month intervals.

What you receive as a participant

■ Personalised CST audit reports after 6 and 12 months

The interval report includes:

- total number of CST patients by age group, results and sample quality
- type of testing
- sample validity
- presence of endocervical cells (for cytology samples)
- routine CST vs co-testing by age group
- CST risk category by age group
- HPV incidence by age group

■ The ability to generate patient lists at any time using Sonic Dx custom views, including results sorted by risk category. This may help doctors to monitor patients transitioning into the new program.

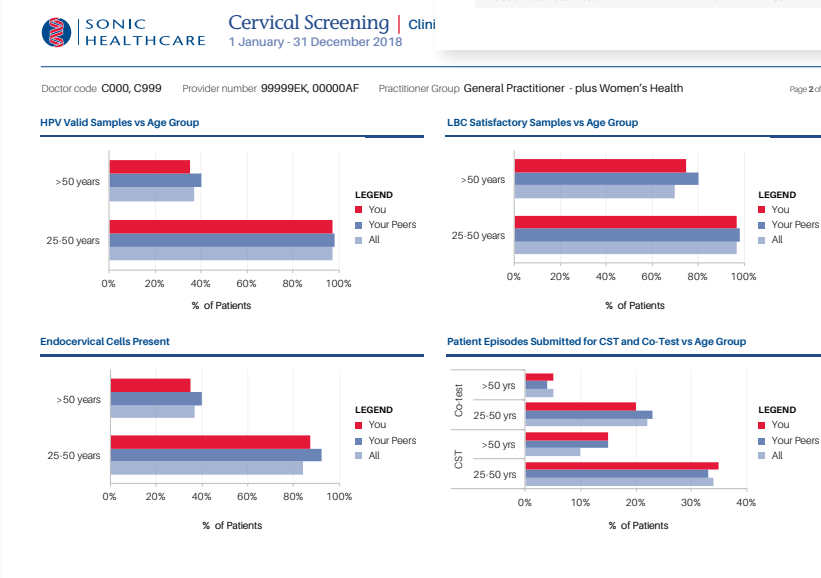
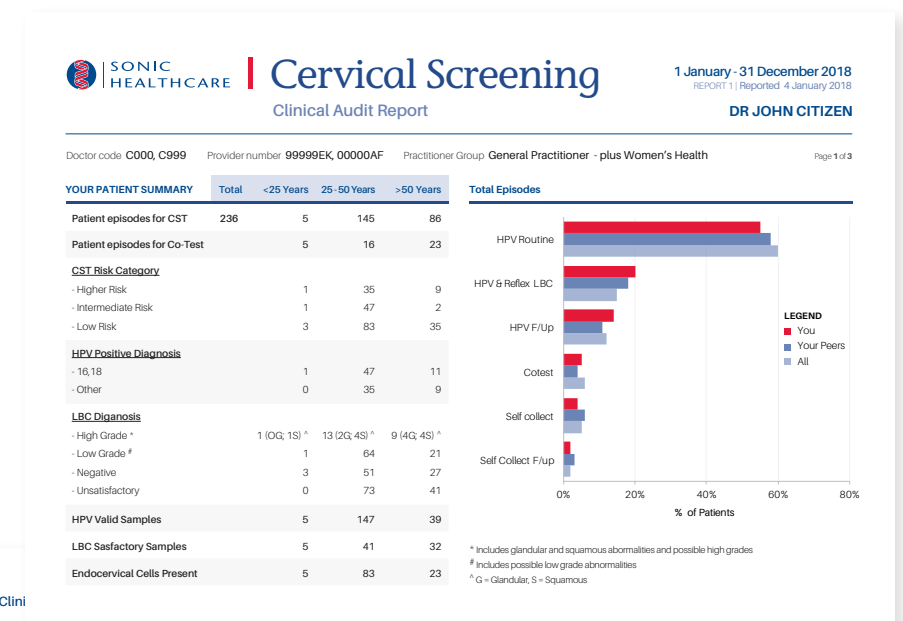
■ Continuing professional development points

Purpose

- To reflect on clinical outcomes by comparing personal findings to a pool of your peers as well as the national GP cohort, including:
 - the frequency of routine, symptomatic and follow-up patient presentations
 - the incidences of HPV types
 - the relative sample adequacy
- To look for practice improvements and educational learning opportunities

Features

- Developed in conjunction with a panel of practising GPs
- Clear graphs for easy comparison of peer group data
- All results are completely confidential
- Produce risk-categorised patient lists using Sonic Dx custom views (available on screen or downloaded in Excel format)



- Enrolment is available to any practitioner who refers women for a CST to Southern IML Pathology
- No minimum number of referrals required (patients included in the clinical audit should be representative of your actual clinical practice)
- One of the largest clinical audits of its kind, with pooled CST data from Sonic Healthcare pathology practices across Australia

Continuing professional development

RACGP – QI & CPD program

Women's Reproductive Health activity
